The regular monthly meeting of the Tolna City Council was held March 10, 2008. All members were present. Others present were Dennis Johnson, Erik Hanssen and Bret Poehls. Minutes were read of February meeting. Russ Baker made the motion to accept as read. Steve Dahl second motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Dennis will attend the water and wastewater school in Bismarck, March 25-27.

Bret Poehls present to inquire of the status of a city website. A discussion was held on domain names. Cityoftolna.com will be the new domain name if available. North Dakota Telephone Co. will set up and host for the city. Software will be purchased by the city to have the ability to make updates when necessary without extra costs.

Steve Dahl made the motion to pay the bills. Ed Poehls second the motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Water and sewer rate increase discussed. To maintain a fund available for repairs etc. an increase of \$4.00/month--\$15.00 basic water and \$5.00 sewer rate. Ed Poehls made the motion to raise rates to \$20.00/ month for 2000 gallons water and sewer and to leave the \$2.00/1000 after the first 2000 gallons the same. The \$20.00 fee will be billed to everyone with a meter in their home. A meter would need to be removed to avoid this charge and a fee would be charged to remove and replace the meter. Steve Dahl second the motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Snow will be moved away from problem culverts in town to help with spring run off.

Erik Hanssen was present to request a liquor and beer license from the city to proceed with his purchase of Junior's bar. A discussion was held on costs and the requirement of the city to have proof of insurance. Russ Baker made the motion to allow the permits when insurance requirements were met. Ed Poehls second the motion. Erik will try to have everything in place for an April 1st opening.

June election discussed briefly. There has not been any petitions received by the auditor as of yet. Petitions are due by 4:00 April 11th to be placed on the ballot.
