A special meeting of the Tolna City Council was held November 20, 2008. All members were present. Others present were Judy Lane.

A discussion was held with Judy on the purchase of Henningsgard Trailer Court. What campers were looking for, what the current charges for camping were and how and what would need to be done to bring trailer court useful for seasonal campers. Sewer dump station would be the first necessity. Steve Dahl made the motion to purchase the trailer court with the city and park each paying one half of the \$5,000.00.

Steve brought maps of city elevations to preview problem areas of water drainage. Several options were discussed and will be tabled to future meetings.

Nelson Co. Health Systems Hospice has requested the use of school gym for future fundraiser. Steve made the motion to lower the cost of use to \$100.00 for this organization fundraiser. Jeremy second the motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

The Living Water Christian School has requested special rates to use gym for their school. A discussion was held on how rates are now set, and the Dakota Prairie school paid \$400.00 for use. There was a unanimous decision that they could pay the membership rates or pay the same as DP.
