Dennis report on shut off valve at water tower needs to be replaced. Vicky will contact Maguire Iron on costs of having project done and time frame of work.

Cooper Paving Co. is in Tolna to do paving projects. Bret and Steve visited with them to get quote on repairing Main Street in front of Post Office. A 10' X 50-60' area would cost approximately \$5,000.00.

Having this section of street fixed was a main concern of residents is surveys done in Horizons Program, and was discussed at that time also. Steve Dahl made the motion to repair that said section of the street repaired by paving company. Jeremy second said motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote, including Bret. Steve will contact Bret to work with the pavers.

Alan Klefstad was present to discuss drainage problems in alley behind PrairieView Lodge Campground. There was discussion on what could be done to fix the problem and who is responsible for costs. Alan will check into the costs of work that has been done to date.

Home Rule Charter discussion was held. Jeremy Gronaas made the motion to approve the framing and submitting for adoption of a home rule charter for the City of Tolna. Steve Dahl second said motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Steve Dahl made motion to continue progress for all Council members to begin the search for individuals to seat the five member Charter Commission. Jeremy Gronaas second said motion. Motion carried.
