Jeremy Weber made the motion to pay the bills. Kayln Luehring second said motion. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

Maguire Iron contract for work to be done on water tower reviewed. Bret made the motion to sign the contract. Jeremy second said motion. Motion carried. Dennis reported work should be done on circulating pump pipes in basement at water tower also. Vicky will contact Maguire Iron and get estimate on this work.

Prairie View Campground water hook-ups were discussed. Kayln made the motion to hire Tolna Plb. to check the connections in the campground. Bret second said motion. Motion carried. Kayln will contact Aaron about the work to get estimate.

Hydrant flush was discussed. Bret suggested purchasing an 18-volt battery operated pump, approximately \$400. Bret made the motion to purchase a battery-operated pump. Jeremy second said motion. Motion carried.

Manhole on Akin Ave. and Gertrude St. still in need of repair. Steve will contact Tri State Paving, Grand Forks, for an estimate on repairs.

Jet-Way bid \$13,050 to video the remainder of sewer lines in town. Bret made the motion to sign contract with Jet-Way to do work specified. Kayln second said motion. Motion carried.

Opoein property response to Dilapidated Building Ordinance violation was to request the removal of the house. The council approved the request, with removal to be completed by August 31st, 2017. Basement must be filled in, and lot cleaned up. Vicky will send response.

A Dilapidated Building Ordinance violation certified letter will be sent out to Jim Baumgartner, Jim Anderson and Curt Twete on violations. The city will continue the letters to residents to get the City cleaned up.

Vicky will check dimensions of the corner lot, North of Stump Lake Storage building. Tronson Grain is interested in the use of the property. Vicky will also check if lot East of TBEC building is on a separate description of land or within description of the TBEC property.
